



2010 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

Tier 1

Funding for Sexual Assault Services	Lead efforts to maintain current funding for sexual assault services.
Victim Privacy	Lead proposals that clarify and remove court authority in ordering victim and witnesses in a criminal case to be deposed and/or to have their interview with defense counsel recorded.
Crime Victims Compensation	Lead efforts to address Crime Victims Compensation funding deficiencies and administration.
Department of Commerce Reorganization	Support a sustainable transition plan that upholds sexual assault priorities, goals, and offers quality administration of sexual assault monies and contractors.

Tier 2

Sex Offender Management	Support proposals which address the sentencing, release, housing and overall management of adult and juvenile sex offenders in order to improve the safety of victims and communities.
DNA Conviction Collection	Support expansion of collection criteria to include DNA collection from individuals whose original charges prior to plea bargain met criteria for collection.
Human Trafficking	Support efforts to improve access to services for survivors of human trafficking.
Child Court Protections	Support decreasing the number of times a child sexual assault victim is interviewed for court processes and support enhancement to victim sensitivity and decreasing intrusive interviewing practices.

Tier 3

Underserved Victims of Crime	Support proposals to improve services to victims of underserved crimes (i.e., homicide, assault, etc).
Special Commitment	Monitor special commitment security information in relation to public disclosure.
